2. **Annual Halloween Food Drive on Saturday, Oct.31st at 5:30p.m.** Take note of the change for 2020, that in order to minimize contact, volunteers will NOT be knocking on doors but will be doing front step pick-up only. This means that those who would like to give will need to pre-pack their donation and place it outside their front door by 5:30p.m. Volunteers will then be by between 5:30-8:00p.m. to pick it up your donation. "Good Buy to Hunger" paper bags that can be used to pack your donation of non-perishable food items in are available at the Boundary Co-op Supermarket or in the church foyer.
3. **Food Drive Volunteers are needed!** We need people who are willing to help by

either 1) *WALKERS* to pick up donations on a designated route. 2) *DRIVERS* who can provide a vehicle to drive for the groups (Most routes are completed in around an hour or less). 3) *SORTERS* who meet at the Lakeview Church gym to sort and box donations for the Food Bank (Most sorting takes place between 6:30-8:00p.m.). 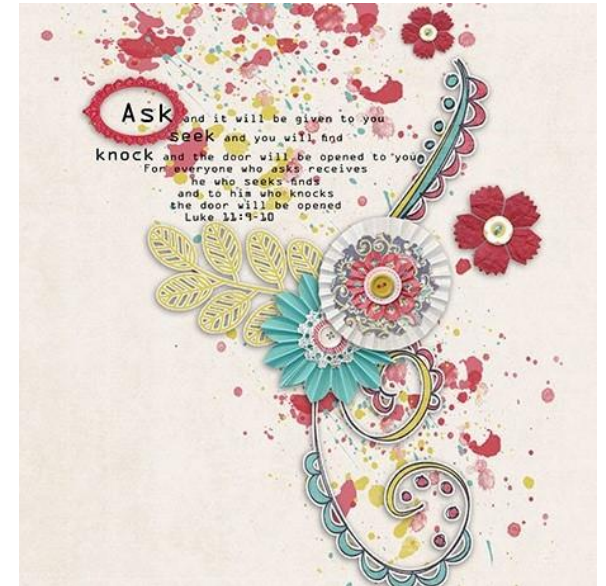
