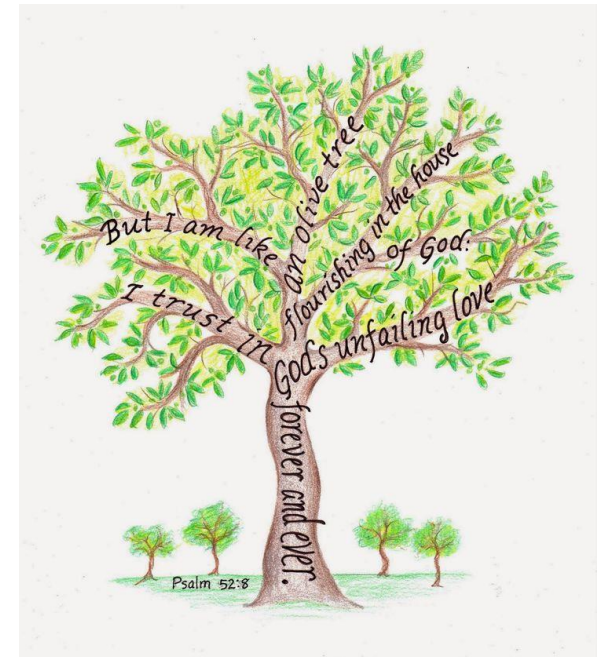
1. **Global Leadership Summit:** If you
