of Christ's sacrifice on our behalf. Children's church will be provided for ages 3-6. Everyone is welcome.

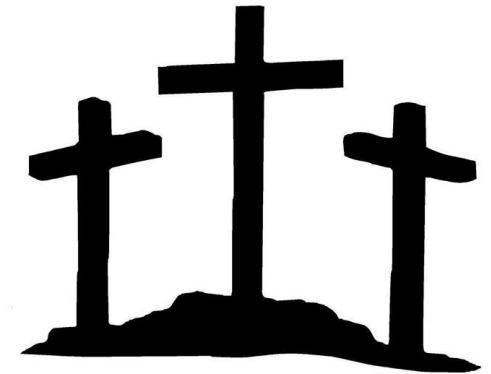
