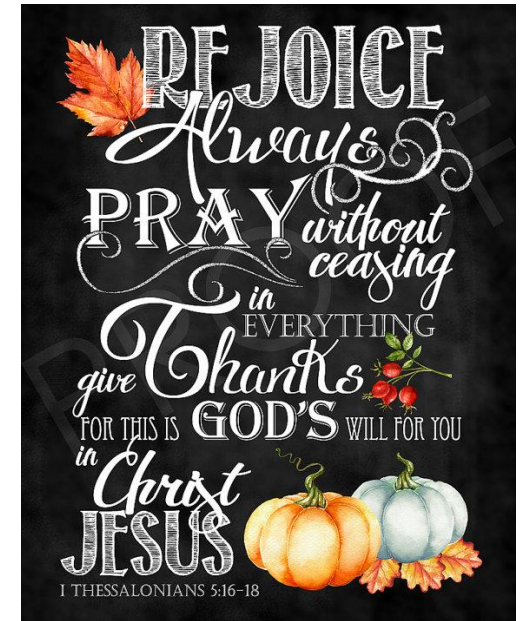
Sunday, Oct.15 - Fall Community Worship
