7. If any of the items on the table at the back of the church belong to you, **please take them home.** After 3 weeks it will be donated to MCC.

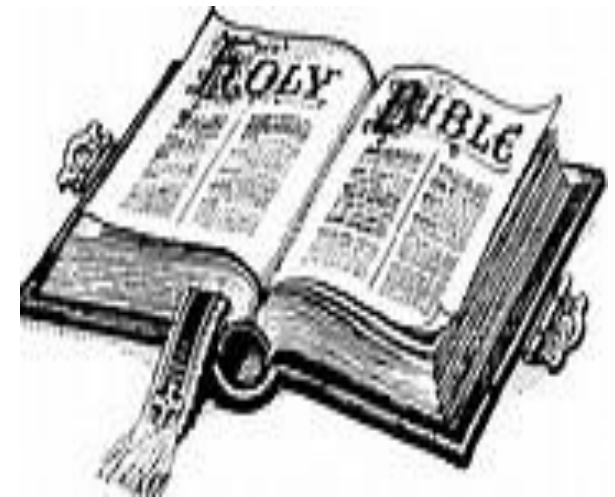
### **Upcoming Events:**
