Refugee Sponsorship Organizing Meeting

Date: Sunday, January 24

Time: 3:00 p.m.

This meeting is for anyone who is interested in volunteering to help with the sponsorship initiative in any capacity.

Volunteers will be needed for a variety of different roles including

1) **The Steering Committee** - This group will spearhead and organize the initiative.

2) **Fundraising**

3) **Housing** - housing arrangements and acquiring household furnishings.

4) **Hands-On Support**- for the refugee families upon arrival - A team of people will be needed for 12 months to share the various support roles the family will need including such things as welcoming the refugee family at the airport, helping settle them into their new home, assisting in familiarizing them to life in a new culture, driving them to the grocery store, hospital, church, school, etc. Additional duties will include: helping with home maintenance and repairs, teaching and/or assisting them with learning to speak English, helping them find employment, and being on-call to help when needed.

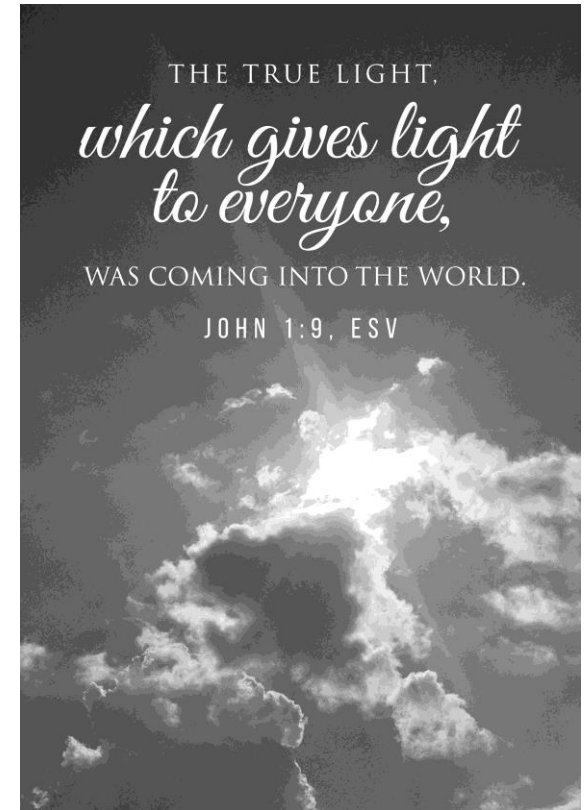
