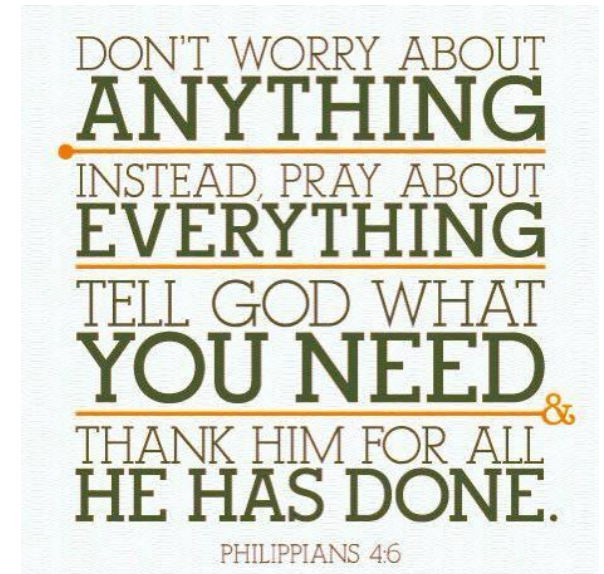
6. **Upcoming Events:**
