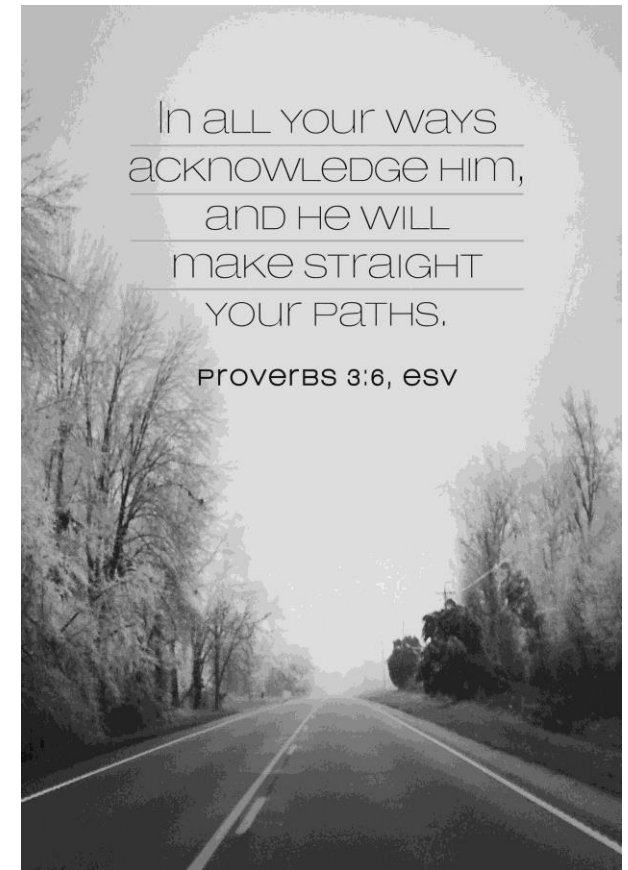
3. **SS Collection Update:** To date we have collected \$2283.05 which is enough to send 11 children to camp this summer!!! Thank you so much for impacting these children for eternity!! And we are not done yet!! We will be collecting until the end of June.
4. **From the Library:** Group study material (books/DVD's) previously used in the S.S. or other study groups has been catalogued and is available in the library for you to sign out. If you need assistance talk to the librarian, Mary Groening.
5. **Child Evangelism Classes** - The **Killarney Ministerial** is looking at the feasibility of offering Discovery Time classes through Child Evangelism Fellowship (cefmanitoba.org) at Killarney Collegiate. Currently, the Gospel is being proclaimed through the ministry of Discovery Time in 46 public schools across Manitoba. We are looking for people who have willing hearts to either teach or help with the Bible-based religious classes (one teacher and one helper required per class). One day of training in the fall and the spring would be required and conducted here in Killarney. Once a week, thirty minute classes would begin next January for grade K-3, and grade 4-6. Each curriculum is 6 weeks long. If you are able to commit to a minimum of 3 or ideally 6 weeks as a teacher or helper, please contact Pastor

Danny by June 20. Please prayerfully consider this opportunity to proclaim the Gospel!
